JUDGMENT OF THE VALUATION TRIBUNAL
ISSUED ON THE 29TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1989

At the oral hearing of the above appeal which took place in Ennis, Co Clare on the 29th November, 1989, Mr Aindrias O'Caoimh, counsel for the respondent questioned the identify of the rated occupier of the above described hereditament.

It seemed to the Tribunal that the correct rated occupier could not easily be identified by either party in the course of the hearing.

In the circumstances, at the close of evidence on behalf of the appellant, the Tribunal adjourned the hearing.

If either party to the appeal wishes to have the correct rated occupier listed in the Valuation List, that should be done. Alternatively, if the parties agree on the legal identity of the occupier and clarify and confirm the position to the Tribunal, a mutually convenient date will be fixed for the resumed hearing.
